Aldersgate Youth Service Bureau is still here for you and your families as a resource and support! During this very challenging time, Aldersgate remains available for phone and on-line support for school staff, SAP counselors, and referred youth and their families.

Who are we? We are a non-profit human services agency located in Willow Grove, PA. Aldersgate offers counseling support and other supportive emotional, behavioral health, and drug and alcohol prevention/intervention services and programs.

What do we do? Aldersgate is currently providing telehealth support services for children, teens, young adults and their families. AYSB staff members are available remotely to schedule free county-funded support programming, including:

- Individual county funded nicotine, drug, and alcohol prevention and intervention programs
 - **Teen Intervene (TI)** is a 3-session individual program to address underage alcohol use, and nicotine use, vaping or smoking.
 - **Marijuana Brief Intervention (MBI)** is a 6-session individual program to address marijuana use, smoking or vaping.
 - **Drug and Alcohol 6 (D&A6)** is a 6-session individual program for students who may be affected by a loved one's and/or their own individual alcohol, nicotine/vaping, marijuana experimentation, use and abuse.
- For teachers, SAP Teams and guidance counselors:
 - **SAP (Student Assistance Program)** support service for school districts. *SAP identifies students who are experiencing behavioral and/or academic difficulties that pose a barrier to their learning and success in school.*
 - **SAP Screening Referrals** (screening to be done remotely) *A SAP screening can help families identify barriers to school success and point you in the direction of resources that can help.*

How can you reach us? Services can be accessed by calling 215-657-4545. Please keep in mind that our staff is working remotely, and clients/parents will need to accept return phone calls from blocked numbers. Email contact information is also appreciated. Students may be school or self-referred. Parents are also encouraged to call the agency directly for support and information related to all available services. If a family needs emergency support, they should contact Montgomery County Mobile Crisis Hotline - Access Services 24/7 at 1-855-634-4673.
